If you have been exposed to some type of literature in your English class, you will soon realize that the literary terminology will be similar. Your summer assignment will consist in reviewing the literary terms for the course as we will be using them while we discuss the various works that we'll be reading throughout the school year.

Make sure that you study all the literary terms, which includes Level 3, 4 & 5. You will be tested on these terms the first week of school, therefore it's necessary that you study them throughout the summer.

Also, there is an extra credit opportunity available as part of your summer assignment. Choose one of the following works, read it and give a summary in Spanish. It will be due on the first class meeting (first day of school).

1. Miguel de Cervantes, *Don Quijote* (primera parte, capítulos 1-5, 8 & 9; segunda parte, capítulo 74) It is best to summarize this work by chapter. You should be able to write at least a paragraph (5 or more sentences) for each section.
2. Tirso de Molina, *El burlador de Sevilla y convidado de piedra*. It is best to summarize this work by Acts as this is a play.
3. Miguel de Unamuno, *San Manuel Bueno, mártir*. This is narrative can best be summarized into 3 parts or 3 paragraphs.

We will revisit these works again during the school year so if you decide not to do the extra credit this will not hurt your grade.
