

2017 Graduation Information

Graduation is approaching fast. The graduation ceremony for the Class of 2017 will be on **May 23** at Grand Canyon University.

*****Special Note***** *Per GCU policy, everyone entering GCU will pass through security and a metal detector wand.*

The ceremony will begin promptly at **8 p.m.** Doors will open at **7 p.m.** Parking will be in the parking garage located off 29th Avenue and Camelback Road.

*****Handicapped Parking Only** will be in the parking garage located off 33rd Avenue and Camelback Road.

The graduation ticket process will begin **April 20**. Packets will be distributed to the students by their government teachers. The packets include a letter from the principal, guidelines and timelines for graduation and a ticket request form.

All graduating students will have the opportunity to receive up to **6 FREE TICKETS**. They will also be able to purchase up to **5 ADDITIONAL TICKETS** at the cost of \$5 each. ****Students must have their School ID to buy and pick up their tickets. There will be no exceptions.**

If students need to purchase additional tickets, they will need to purchase them from the Bookstore before receiving their six free tickets. **Bookstore dates and hours for purchasing ticket** are May 1-5 before school, during lunch and after school. After purchasing their extra tickets, they need to bring their completed ticket request form, with the receipt attached, to the Records Office to receive all their tickets.

There is a limited amount of additional tickets available, so please buy your tickets early. **Records Office dates and hours for ticket pick-up** are May 1-5 from 7 a.m. to 7:50 a.m. and 2:35 p.m. - 4 p.m. The Records Office **WILL NOT** be open during lunches to pick up tickets.

If students only need free tickets, they need to go to the Records Office with their completed ticket request form during the dates and times listed above.

*****Note, if your graduating student does not have a government class, they must see Ms. Kiehn in Records on April 20 to receive their packet.**

If your family is in need of handicapped seating for people with wheelchairs or walkers, please have your graduating student see Ms. Kiehn in Records ASAP.

If your graduating student has not ordered their cap and gown, please call National Graduation Products ASAP. (602) 978-8169. Please remember, students cannot walk at graduation if they are not in their cap and gown.
