THE REGISTRATION PROCESS

Sunnyslope High will keep the same process as last year in its summer walk-through registration process. We believe that this is an efficient process, and has many benefits for you and your family. This year, SHS will require walk through registration for all Sunnyslope students. Walk-through registration for incoming freshmen will take place on Tuesday, July 25 and the morning of Wednesday, July 26. Upperclassmen will have walk-through registration on Wednesday, July 26 through Friday, July 28. (schedule is included in this mailer). Please note the following below:

- **Only freshmen students will be allowed to go through walk through registration during their scheduled times (no upperclassmen will be allowed through walk through registration during freshmen times (no exceptions).**
- **Upper classmen will have their walk through registration times by alphabet. We will not be doing different grade levels at different times. This allows siblings to register at the same time**
- Parking Passes (Seniors only with prior completed application process)
 - Seniors may come to attendance office prior to school starting to pick up their parking pass and sign the contract. Seniors may pick up their parking passes in the attendance office on Thursday, August 3 (7:30-3:00) and Friday, August 4 (7:30-noon). Senior parking passes will not be distributed at walk-through registration.

Mail-In Registration

School starts on August 7, 2017. Since some Sunnyslope High School families will be on vacation during walk-through registration, a special mail-in registration form is available. Therefore, if you plan to be out of town during walk-through registration, but still plan to attend SHS, please complete the form below and return it to SHS before July 21, 2017. This will keep your classes intact and your registration active. Otherwise, your schedule will be dropped, and you will have to re-enroll.

MEDICATIONS

A medication form must be completed at the beginning of each school year, for each medication, and each time there is a change in dosage or time of administration. Form must be signed by healthcare professional or copy of doctor's order given to nurse.

The medication must come to the school office in the original labeled prescription container or if it is over the counter medication, in the original container with all the directions and warning intact. Expired medication will not be administered.

All non-used medications need to be picked up by the end of each school year. Any leftover medication will be disposed of the last week of school.

Walk-Through Registration

At walk-through registration, students will receive their class lists. Official schedules will be handed out on the first day of school. Some freshmen may be required to take a diagnostic test to ensure proper placement in English and Math.

To complete registration: Freshmen

1. **BIRTH CERTIFICATE:**
The federal CHILD FIND law requires that all students present their original birth certificate upon first registering at a new school.
2. **PROOF OF ADDRESS:**
Current utility bill and/or lease/mortgage agreement, which includes name and address of the property.
3. **PROOF OF GRADUATION**
Proof of promotion from the eighth grade; Diploma, letter of promotion, etc.
4. **UPDATE IMMUNIZATIONS**
Be current with shots. Please send/bring documentation of any booster shots to nurse by the first day of school.

Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors

5. **CLEAR ALL DEBTS**
Debts must be cleared prior to walk through registration.
6. **UPDATE IMMUNIZATIONS**
Be current with shots. Please send/bring documentation of any booster shots to nurse by the first day of school.
7. **SIGNED HEALTH CARD**
Complete and sign the white health card included in this mailer, and return at walk through registration.

Seniors Must

1. **REGISTER VEHICLES**
Register each vehicle that will be driven to school. Only seniors will be issued permits for the school parking lot. Vehicle registration, driver's license and proof of insurance will be required to obtain your \$25.00 parking permit.

WALK-THROUGH REGISTRATION SCHEDULE

ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND WALK-THROUGH REGISTRATION.

Please arrive at your designated time. Students will be admitted by the following schedule.

Alphabet refers to the first letter of the student's last name.

During the freshmen allocated times, ONLY freshmen will be able to attend walk-through registration.

Any freshmen students registering on Wednesday, July 26, Thursday, July 27 and Friday, July 28 must be in line prior to 11:00 AM. This is to guarantee the student completes the registration process. Freshmen students/parents attempting walk-through registration after these times, on these days, will not be allowed to register.
